WHAT THIS IS

- A peaceful prayer assembly
- A firm public stand for the truth according to the Word of God which we have surrendered our lives to
- An opportunity to pray for hurting people and minister healing
- An empowerment of citizens to engage in reformation strategies to turn their state back to God (i.e. participate in school board meetings, run for local offices, etc.)
- An establishment of long-term prayer strategies that will strengthen the body of believers and cause spiritual transformation in the state
- Inviting unbelievers to receive Christ and become a part of the body
- A gathering to unify us as a nation
- A collaborative effort by many individuals and organizations
- A catalyst to build momentum to a historic gathering in Washington, D.C.

WHAT THIS IS NOT

- A violent protest (we will stand in love, humility, peace and Truth)
- An event only for Christians (we welcome all people regardless of their faith, gender, race, economic status, or background)
- An opportunity to express bitterness toward people (we are not in a fight with people but acknowledge this is a spiritual battle)
- An opportunity for any one person or ministry to climb the ranks of influence
- An event organized by only one organization



SUPPORTING SCRIPTURES

When the godly are in authority, the people rejoice. But when the wicked are in power, they groan.

Proverbs 29:2

This is what the Lord of Heaven's Armies says: "Consider all this, and call for the mourners. Send for the women who mourn at funerals. Quick! Begin your weeping! Let the tears flow from your eyes. Hear the people of Jerusalem crying in despair, 'We are ruined! We are completely humiliated! We must leave our land, because our homes have been torn down." Listen, you women, to the words of the Lord; open your ears to what he has to say. Teach your daughters to wail; teach one another how to lament. Each state has a team and is made up of sub-teams.

All teams and sub-teams hold a collective responsibility to:

- 1. Market the event
- 2. Fundraise for the event
- 3. Recruit volunteers

This will make it possible to have the largest event possible.

Your team will:

- Step 1. Meet your State Captain
- Step 2. Assemble into appropriate Sub-Teams
- Step 3. Determine your team's vision/goals for the day
- Step 4: Follow the Event Blueprint given to you for the day
- Step 5. Hold a historical gathering at your state capital on 4/13/24
- Step 6. Send people into reformation strategies to turn your state back to God!

Non-negotiables:

- 1. Agree to the vision (in all efforts, activity, communication, & marketing, etc.)
- 2. Agree to put Prayer and Communion as the foundation of the event
- 3. Agree to include prayer points and declaration given by Leadership
- 4. Make a strong call to gather in Washington, D.C.
- 5. Use the template / time frame provided for the event
- 6. Use the event graphic(s) we provide for your state
- 7. Call for a 3-Day fast 3 days prior to the event (no designated type of fast; must be decided by the individual).
- 8. Make a strong call to meet in prayer groups (hubs, hives, etc.)
- 9. Provide reformation strateg(ies) that will bring the kingdom into spheres of society

TEAMS

Leads: Jenny Donnelly

Capitols Director: Naomi Van Wyk

Each State has a CAPTAIN who directs and leads SUB-TEAMS

Captain: This is the main director for the event. They are responsible for:

- 1. Regular communication with Cynthia Pena (Capitols Director)
- 2. Direction, strategy and leadership to the sub-teams
- 3. Recruiting and direction for:
 - a. sub-team positions
 - b. attendees for the day
 - c. select speakers (following a specific protocol)
 - d. optional worship team
- 4. Set attendance goals with your team
- 5. Set a budget with your team (according to your goals)
- 6. Secure a funding strategy to disseminate
- 7. Agree to use marketing materials provided from Lead Operations

SUB-TEAMS: Each team can be ONE individual or multiple individuals who make up a team, depending on the size of your capitol gathering.

Admin(s): This is the administrator of the event. They are responsible for:

- 1. Regular communication with State Captain
- 2. Schedule and obtain (when applicable to your state):
 - a. Acquiring the Permits
 - b. Renting A/V Equipment
 - c. Booking travel
 - d. communion
- 3. Keep track of funding/budget

Volunteer Coordinator(s): This team is in charge of building and directing volunteer teams. Volunteers consist of:

- 1. Prayer team (on the ground, not from the front)
- 2. Care team (parking, garbage, info booth, etc.)
- 3. Worship Team / Person (optional)



TEAMS

Marketing Director(s): This team is in charge of getting the word out to their state, merging with the overall national strategy. Responsibilities consist of:

- a. Working with the national team for graphics provided
- b. Providing social media content for the team to use
- c. Creating grass roots strategies

Mobilizers: These are people who will spend their energy mobilizing their sphere of influence to their state capitols. This might look like:

- a. Marketing to their audience through personal podcasts, prayer meetings, preaching, video marketing, social media, chartering buses, organizing caravans, etc.
- b. Inviting other local leaders to team up for prayer, strategies to mobilize, etc.
